(**Please note:** Only one note needs to be written to the homeroom teacher and the note will be shared with the sixth grade team).

- 1 Pack of Post-It {Multi-color -Size 1 ½ x 2 in}
- 4 Black Dry Erase Markers –Fine TIP for writing/**ONE OLD CLEAN SOCK**
- 1 Large bottle of Hand Sanitizer
- 1 Container of Clorox Wipes
- 1 Box of Tissues {For Classroom Use}
- 1 Box of 16 Crayons {Will remain in school}

**MANDATORY: FREE LIBRARY CARD IS REQUIRED FOR OUTSIDE RESEARCH AND CURRENT EVENTS. DUE BY OCT. 1<sup>ST</sup>.**

**PLEASE LABEL ALL ITEMS WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME AND ROOM NUMBER**

**Homework** will be given Monday –Thursday. All homework assignments will be **posted on Google classroom and copied in an agenda**, which will be given to your child in September. All assignments are to be completed on loose-leaf paper and properly headed. **A parent must sign all tests results below a 70.**

If your child is pulled out for music lessons during instructional time or chooses to participate in **ALL CITY** he or she must turn in all assignments on time and make up any missed tests the day after an **ALL CITY** practice. Please be advised although **ALL CITY** is a very prestigious honor it is a very serious commitment.

Lockers are a new experience for all incoming GAMP students. It was recommended, that you purchased a combination lock, over the summer in order to give your child time to practice how to open their locker using a dial lock. **Please note your child will not need this lock for school.** Your child will be given a locker that has a built in lock.

Both breakfast and lunch are **free** –see The GAMP website for the start time for breakfast.

**Health-Related Issues/Concerns**-If your child has any special health problems please let me know.

**Cell Phone Policy**- **all cell phones are to be powered off and kept out of sight. NO exceptions. If you have a need to speak with your child during the school day please contact the main office. (This does not apply to cell phones being used for instructional purposes.)**

**Here are the consequences if your child chooses not to adhere to this school policy:**

1<sup>st</sup> offense- The phone is confiscated labeled with the child's name and returned to him/her at the end of the school day.

2<sup>nd</sup> Offense- Same as first offense and 1 after-school detention is given.

3<sup>rd</sup> Offense – Same as 2<sup>nd</sup> offense and the parent must come to school to retrieve the cell phone.
